<b>AZALEAS</b> <b>Broadleaf evergreen shrubs with colorful May flowers.</b> <b>CULTURE:</b> Filtered light or morning sun and afternoon shade; rich, acidic, organic soil with excellent drainage. Azaleas will not grow well in full sun or in clay soil. Use a 2-3" layer of mulch to keep roots cool and moist; too much will block oxygen flow into the soil and suffocate roots. Keep mulch pulled several inches away from the base of plants; <u>do not</u> plant any deeper than shrub was in its original container. <b>USE:</b> Shady borders; edge of woodland; massing; informal hedge; oriental gardens; attract hummingbirds; some can be used in the rock garden or as edgers and ground covers.

Keep mulch pulled several inches away from the base of plants; <u>do not</u> plant any deeper than shrub was in its original container. <b>USE:</b> Shady borders; edge of woodland; massing; natural gardens; massing; background; some can be used in the rock garden.
